

WPS –STUDENT **MANAGEMENT POLICY**

For period: June 2014 – June 2018

Rationale:

- Positive and responsible student behaviour is essential to the smooth running of the school, to the achievement of optimal learning opportunities and to the development of a supportive and cooperative school.

Aims:

- To build a school environment based on positive behaviours and values
- To manage negative and positive behaviours in a professional and consistent manner
- To establish well understood and logical consequences for student behaviour
- To support the individual needs of students and enhance self discipline

Implementation:

- Our school has developed, through a process of wide community consultation, school wide values. These values outline the agreed behaviours within the whole school community.
- The Student Management documentation will encompass processes for positive and negative behaviours, outline major and minor incidents and will be aligned with the school values.
- The Student Management Policy will embrace the overarching KidsMatter initiative, implemented across the school.
- At the beginning of the year will also be focused upon building a positive learning community through the implementation of the Wandong Primary School T.E.A.M. (Together Everyone Achieves More) program with an emphasis on developing a cohesive learning environment.
- Each classroom teacher, in consultation with the students in that particular class, will create a classroom code of cooperation that will outline clearly the expectations for the coming year.
- Positive student behaviour achievement will appropriately be recognised and valued through the use of Gold Tickets, Student Achievement Tickets, Gold Certificates, Student of The Week Certificates and House Points.
- Consequences for inappropriate behaviour may include Time Out, Lunch Time and After School Detentions, Behaviour Contracts, Community Service, loss of privileges or suspension.
- All staff will be equipped with a Student Management Folder and undertake professional learning on student behaviour and discipline processes.
- An up to date student record for both positive and negative consequences will be maintained.
- The school curriculum will include classroom learning activities focused on our student values.
- Parents will be kept informed and actively encouraged to assist in the development of their children's behavioural performance.
- The school will provide a range of positive extra curricula activities for students including leadership, sporting and theatrical.
- Students experiencing difficulty in achieving positive behavioural outcomes will undertake individualised behaviour management programs focusing on agreed goals. This will be in consultation with the Principal, classroom teacher, student and parent/guardian.

Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed in line with the school's review cycle.
